

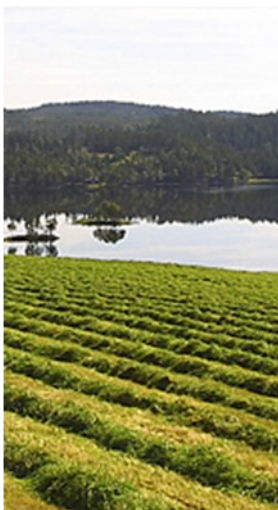
A sampling of Products:

Six Rivers Market is a local food cooperative centered in Sandpoint, ID with a web-based storefront. **This provides a convenient way for**

co-op members to shop from home, day or night, and minimizes costs for each of us to access high quality, local food.

The Market provides a means for co-op members to sell their products via the web, allowing each member the ability to create their own webpage to tell their story and sell their product in a general marketplace. **Any member can sell through the co-op**, whether that member has truckloads of product to sell or just a few baskets! This enables all of us to share our bounty and create a more sustainable food network. It's also just fun!

To support the system, Producers pay the co-op a 6% handling fee to sell through the co-op and Consumers pay a 6% handling fee on each order.

To join the co-op, community members make an investment in the Market by paying a membership fee which entitles each member one vote towards the direction of the co-op (and allows each member to shop!). Members vote for a Board of Directors who collectively govern the direction of the Market. **As a nonprofit**, Six Rivers Market returns all profits to the future of the business and co-op members. **Six Rivers Market was created as a donation** to the community, solely for the community's benefit.



How does Six Rivers Market work?

- **You join the co-op** and pay an annual or monthly membership fee. This is your investment in the co-op and enables you to login and shop through the co-op website.
- **You shop from home!** Each weekend you will find a new selection of products to purchase and pick up the following Wednesday. When you arrive your order is all packaged and ready to go!
- **You can become a producer too!** For no additional fee you can submit a Producer Registration form letting us know what products you would like to sell. Just think of the possibilities!
- **You direct the co-op** and network with other customers and the producers who make your food. We work together to make this a true community marketplace!
- **Everyone benefits** by keeping our food dollars local and encouraging increased local food production.

Order Cycle

As Six Rivers Market is simply a means for Producers to sell their product, we hold no inventory and have no physical storefront. To make the system work, we run on weekly order cycles with one Delivery Day a week to a central Sandpoint location, the **Sandpoint Events Center at 102 S. Euclid Street**.

Friday, Week 1: Deadline for all product to be posted for the upcoming Delivery Day.

Saturday, Week 1: The Order Cycle opens and members can begin shopping.

Monday, Week 2: The Order Cycle closes and Producers receive a list of all product sold.

Tues.-Wed., Week 2: Producers harvest and package whatever product they have sold.

Wednesday: Delivery Day!

1:30-3:00PM Producers Deliver Product and receive payment.

3:00-3:30PM Six Rivers organizes all product into individual customer orders.

3:30-6:00PM Customers pick up their orders, in one convenient box or bag.

Friday, Week 2: Process Repeats!
